Para sets these parameters in harmony with the dyestuff suppliers, using only the highest quality chemicals that are most suitable for natural-fibre fabrics, where alternative formulations (and therefore performances) do not exist.

Please also remember the obvious differences in performance between a natural-fibre fabric and a man-made fibre fabric. Para can only accept a claim from a customer if the fabrics do not conform to Para's stated figures.

Claims

Incorrect or non-delivery, or split or broken palettes etc. must be notified within 24 hours of receipt of goods. Notification must be in writing, accompanied by photographs where possible. If goods arrive in poor condition, please DO NOT sign for them as approved.

Fabric quality issues must be notified in writing within 7 days of receipt.
